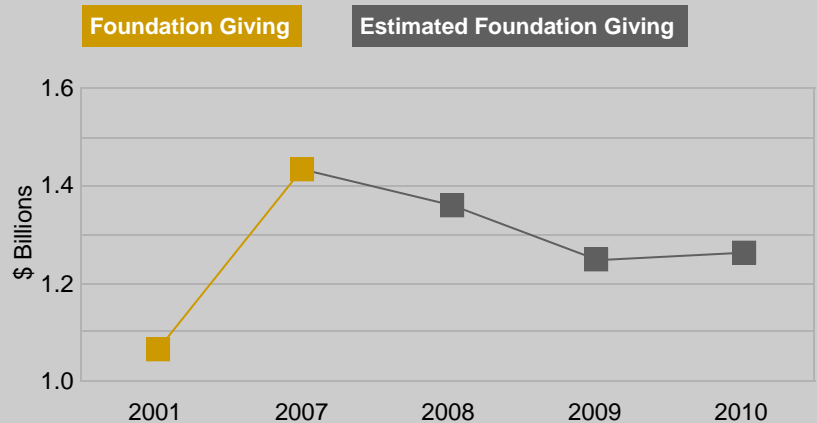


Florida Philanthropy At A Glance

Florida is home to more than **4,000 active grantmaking foundations and corporate givers**. In 2007 (the last year for which complete data are available), these grantmakers held more than **\$22.1 billion in charitable assets** and gave more than **\$1.4 billion in grants** to charitable organizations and causes. When you add in giving by individual Floridians, charitable giving in Florida totaled **\$17.7 billion**.

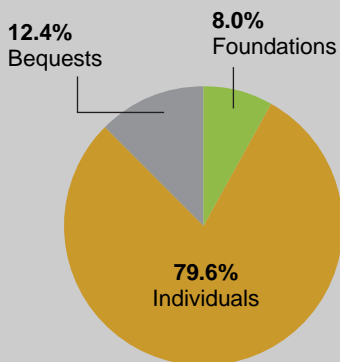
Giving by Florida grantmakers increased **32%** between 2001 and 2007 and is estimated to have declined by **3%** in 2008 and by more in 2009. However, the state's grantmaking is expected to stabilize or increase slightly in 2010, according to FPN research.

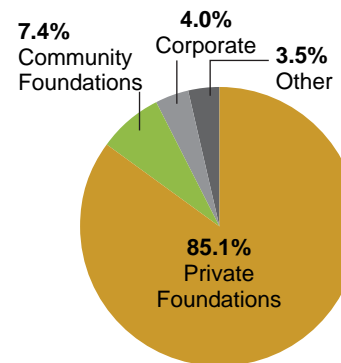

Charitable Giving by Individual Floridians

- Individual Floridians gave **\$14.1 billion** to charity in 2007.
- **75%** of Floridians donated money to a charitable organization during 2008.
- **23%** of Floridians gave less than \$100 to charitable organizations in Florida in 2008, while an additional **24%** gave between \$100 and \$250. **14%** of Florida residents gave more than \$1,000 to charity.
