Selby Foundation Awards 2nd Quarter “Small and Mighty” Grants to Four Area Nonprofits

SARASOTA, Florida - The William G. and Marie Selby Foundation has awarded its 2nd Quarter 2022 “Small and Mighty” (SAM) grants totalling \$24,155 to four area nonprofits. These awards will be used for capital purchases and technology upgrades that allow the organizations to more effectively expand on delivering their mission to the community. The benefitting organizations are:
