# **Tour Academy Prep, Lakeland**

#### 1021 Lakeland Hills Blvd, Lakeland, FL 33805

Academy Prep Centers for Education are private, non-profit middle schools serving low-income students in grades 5-8. At Academy Prep we are committed to caring for the whole child. We are improving educational equity by offering our students, some of the most marginalized children in our community, access and opportunities to academic and social-emotional support. We know that academic achievement will not only change the trajectory of a student's life, but also the life of their family and community. Academy Prep works with our students, who are all low-income, and our graduates, who are predominantly first-generation college-going students, to overcome any challenge or obstacle they encounter during their educational journey so that they not only enroll in college but graduate. Academy Prep's vision is to achieve academic excellence from middle school through college; foster personal integrity; and make a lifelong commitment to service in their communities.

Every student attends on full scholarship - \$20,000 annually per student--raised from individuals, foundations, corporations, and organizations. Each student receives up to four years of tuition-free, college-preparatory education. Students attend up to 11 hours a day, 6 days a week, 11 months each year. Class size is typically 20 or less with most courses taught separately by gender. Through these core components of the Academy Prep model, we are working towards eliminating generational poverty through education.

#### Selected Academy Prep results:

- 99% of Academy Prep graduates have graduated from high school on time
- 83% of Academy Prep graduates have enrolled in college
- 86% of Academy Prep class of 2023 were at or above grade level in Reading on the nationally
- 77% of Academy Prep class of 2023 were at or above grade level in Math on the nationally
