Florida Philanthropic Network is a 501(c)(3) organization; therefore, membership investments may be paid in the form of a grant.

MEMBERSHIP ELIGIBILITY

To qualify for FPN membership, an organization's principal function must be the making of grants for charitable, religious, educational or scientific purposes, and its annual grant distributions must be made to multiple organizations that are not subsidiaries of or related to the grantmaker, rather than to one institution.

In addition, a grantmaking public charity must operate a competitive grantmaking program and commit more than 50% of its annual expenditures to such a program.

MEMBERSHIP TERMS

Dues are applied to FPN membership from January 1 – December 31 of each calendar year, with membership renewed at the start of each calendar year.

For new members, membership dues are prorated for the first year based on the month joined.

NON-SOLICITATION POLICY

All FPN members understand that it is not appropriate to solicit donations at FPN programs, events and other functions. Collaborative grantmaking, however, is to be encouraged.

Organizations that have a dual grantmaking and grantseeking role agree that their development staff will not utilize FPN activities or resources for fundraising/development purposes.
